

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR KIWANIS GRANT REQUESTS**

## PRIORITIES and VALUES

- 1. Is there a perceived need for the Funds requested?
- 2. What is the impact on the public, the project itself, and to the Club (if this request is funded)?
- 3. Projects serving Rock Island residents will have priority over other funding requests.

Priorities for funding are:

- Children & Youth
- Literacy

- Economically Challenged
- Serving Developmentally Disabled
- Health & Wellness

## **Grant Practices**

- 1. Grants are awarded the final Monday of April. Grant applications are due by midnight 3/1/24.
- 2. Late grants will not be accepted.
- 3. A grants committee made of Kiwanis members will review submitted requests and make recommendations to the Board of Directors in accordance with the above priorities and values.
- 4. The Board of Directors will act on grants requests annually, in late March.
- 5. The upper limit for a grant request will be determined by the Board of Directors; however, the average grant request ranges from \$500 to \$1,000.
- 6. One grant request will be accepted for each project/organization in each Kiwanis fiscal year (October 1st through September 30th).
- 7. Repetition or approval of previous projects should not outweigh approval of new projects.
- 8. Grant recipients are expected to attend the grant award presentation meeting (held the 4th Monday of April at noon ), and are expected to acknowledge the grant.
